Charles' Story

On March 8, 2007, our eight year old son, Charles Reges, was hit by a car near Potomac Village, Maryland. Charles was air-lifted to Children's National Medical Center in Washington, DC with life threatening injuries. Charles suffered traumatic brain injury, a broken leg, a bruised lung and spent 14 days in a coma and 51 days in the hospital overall. Due to the hard work of many doctors and nurses at Children's National Medical Center, Charles not only survived, but his recovery is nothing short of miraculous.
